

Spring 2021 Arrival and Self-Quarantine Facilities Application Guide

Office of International Affairs

Seoul National University

1. Summary

This guide contains the application procedure for “Siheung Campus Self-Quarantine Facilities”. SNU OIA offers for students who are required to self-quarantine for 14 days upon arrival to Korea at Seoul National University Siheung Campus Hotel & Convention Center. Please note that there may be additional changes in the guidelines and information, and students must comply with the latest version of the guidance at all times.

2. Arrival (Airport to Self-Quarantine Facilities)

All entrants who reside in Korea must receive a COVID-19 diagnostic test immediately upon arrival at the local public health center’s screening clinics. **It is mandatory that each person DOES NOT use public transportation** and instead uses a personal vehicle or **specially designated shuttle taxi/bus** when going to receive their mandatory COVID-19 test. Please note that all individuals are required to undergo a mandatory self-quarantine for 14 days from the next day, regardless of their test results.

○ Arrival Guide (Wear a mask all the time during the travel)

- 1) Upon arrival, go to the emergency shuttle bus waiting area (Zone 5 ~ 8 bound for Siheung-si), fill out the passenger form, and **take the bus 7000**. Passengers are only allowed to get off at the bus stops designated by the district office.
- 2) Get off at the local district office (Siheung-si Jeongwang-dong E-Mart), and receive the COVID-19 diagnostic test at Siheung Jeongwang Public Health Center’s Screening Clinics.
- 3) After the diagnostic test, take the specially designated transportation again (free), and head to the SNU Siheung Campus Hotel & Convention Center self-quarantine facilities.
- 4) You will be given further guidance for move-in and self-quarantine.

○ Shuttle Bus (#7000) Timetable (Subject to change, fare: KRW 5,300)

- Due to the limited operation hours of the district office’s screening clinic (tests available to passengers who arrive before 6 pm through the bus #3), we advise you to change your flight schedule according to the schedule below. If you take a specially designated taxi, it will cost around 50,000 KRW.

3. Self-Quarantine Facilities at Siheung Campus

* Students who will reside in SNU dormitories (Gwanaksa) after the self-quarantine utilize the university shuttle bus from Siheung Campus to the dormitories.

Please note that if you wish to stay at the self-quarantine facilities at Siheung Campus, you are required to pay a fee. Please read the information below carefully and make sure that you apply for our university-provided quarantine facilities at least 3 days before your departure from your home country.


Please note that the self-quarantine requirement applies only to new entrants to Korea (including return and re-entry to Korea), and therefore, students who are currently residing in Korea are not required to undergo self-quarantine.

In case you change your mind and cancel your application, your spot will be given to a person in the waiting list and you will have to reapply again if you wish to self-quarantine at the Siheung Campus facilities.)
- Operation Period	- 2021.2.1.(Mon) ~ 2021.3.14.(Sun) - You MUST check in between 2.1. (Mon)~2. 28. (Sun) and keep in mind that the self-quarantine period is 14 days. (e.g., if you arrive on Feb 1, self-quarantine is over at 12:00 p.m. Feb 15)

- How to Apply	- <u>Submit the application form through the link below and pay for the fee BEFORE MOVE IN</u> ★Link: https://forms.gle/pGZc8xeTcC1k1Nn86 - No hard copy documents are required
- Fee for Self-Quarantine	- For Quarantine: USD 900 (around USD 65 per day, 14 days) - Total: USD 900 - Fee must be wired to a bank account number that will be announced in subsequent updates. Please keep in mind that while doing a wire transfer, that extra fees such as transfer fee may occur.
- Others	- We will be providing all students with three meals a day (Included in the total fee of USD 900). Meals will be delivered to your room.

* If you do not complete the application and fee payment in time, you are not allowed to move into the self-quarantine facilities. Bank account information will be provided at a later time for students who finish the application.

* Due to the limited number of rooms available per day, not every applicant will be accepted. We will further notice you in case we are unable to accommodate you on a certain day.

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION SHOULD BE USED ONLY AS A GUIDELINE. PLEASE NOTE THAT **SNU DOES NOT PROVIDE QUARANTINE FACILITIES AT THE GWANAK CAMPUS. IF YOU WISH TO STAY AT QUARANTINE FACILITIES PROVIDED BY SNU OIA, PLEASE REFER TO THE INFORMATION ABOVE REGARDING THE SIHEUNG CAMPUS QUARANTINE FACILITIES.**

<Incheon Airport to Gwanak-gu Transportation>

- All entrants who reside in Seoul must be tested immediately upon arrival at the local public health center's screening clinic.
- All Seoul residents **must** travel by a personal vehicle or specially arranged shuttle taxi/bus.
- Please refrain from using public transportation when going to receive your COVID-19 test.

- How take a shuttle bus to Gwanak-gu?

- 1) Upon arrival, go to the emergency shuttle bus waiting area (Zone 4). (Incheon Airport – Terminal 1 (1F), Terminal 2 (B1F)).
- 2) Check the bus routes and fill out the passenger form. Passengers are only allowed to get off at bus stops designated by the district office.
- 3) Take the shuttle bus to your local district office.
- 4) Get off at the district office and follow the instructions given by the person in charge at the district office. You may be scheduled to receive the COVID-19 diagnostic test immediately or be asked to head directly to your residence. For the latter case, ride the district office vehicle if possible and visit the screening clinic again within 2 days.

○ **Shuttle Bus Timetable (Subject to change, fare: KRW 16,000)**

- Due to the limited operation hours of the district office's screening clinic (tests available to passengers who arrive before 6 pm through the bus #2), you are required to change your flight schedule accordingly

Coronavirus Disease-19 (COVID-19)

MANDATORY QUARANTINE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL INCOMING TRAVELERS TO REPUBLIC OF KOREA

In accordance with the Quarantine Act and the Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act, **all incoming travelers, regardless of nationality, shall be subject to mandatory 14-day quarantine** beginning on the date of entry and ending at 12:00 of the 15th day. (For example, if you arrived on 1 June, you are required to stay under mandatory quarantine until 12:00 of 15 June.)

ONCE YOU ARRIVE AT AIRPORT

- ✓ Wear a facemask at all times and avoid contact or talking with other people.
- ✓ You are required to be tested if you have suspected symptoms.
- ✓ **FOREIGNERS ON SHORT-TERM VISIT** are required to enter mandatory quarantine (at their own expense) at a facility designated by the Korean government.
 - **IF YOU BOARDED FROM EUROPE OR THE UNITED STATES:**
You will be tested at an open walk-through screening station at airport and enter quarantine/isolation at a temporary living facility.
 - **IF YOU BOARDED FROM COUNTRY/REGION OTHER THAN ABOVE:**
You will enter mandatory quarantine at a temporary living facility and **will be tested within 14 days.**
- ✓ Note) Those who have valid quarantine exemption are required to be tested and will be subject to active monitoring for 14 days by designated public health officials. The designated official will check and monitor their health conditions for 14 days.
 - * Valid quarantine exemptions are:
 - Pre-approved waiver from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; or
 - A1 (diplomat on duty) or A2 (government official on duty) visa or a "quarantine exemption document" issued in advance by a Korean Embassy.
- ✓ **FOREIGNERS ON LONG-TERM VISIT** (i.e. living in Korea) are required to enter mandatory quarantine in their homes.
 - **IF YOU BOARDED FROM EUROPE OR THE UNITED STATES:**
If you do not have symptoms at the time of entry, you may leave the airport and enter your mandatory home quarantine.
However, you are required to visit a screening center and get tested within the next 3 days, regardless of symptoms.
 - **IF YOU BOARDED FROM ALL OTHER COUNTRIES:**
If you do not have symptoms at the time of entry, you may leave the airport and enter your mandatory home quarantine.
However, you are required to visit a screening center, contact the public health center of jurisdiction and get tested within the next 3 days (i.e. during your home quarantine period), regardless of symptoms.
* Further actions may follow contingent on test result.
- ✓ **FOR ALL PERSONS SUBJECT TO MANDATORY FACILITY QUARANTINE:**
 - Use the designated transit vehicle to move to your designated quarantine facility.

FOR ALL PERSONS SUBJECT TO MANDATORY HOME QUARANTINE:

- When you leave the airport, do not take public transportation.
Use a personal car or designated mode of transit (designated airport limousine bus or KTX train).
- * Go home directly from the airport. Do not make stops in other locations.
- As soon as you arrive home, call your local public health center to inform them that you are under quarantine.
- Install the "HOME QUARANTINE SAFETY PROTECTION" app by the Ministry of the Interior and Safety on your phone. (This is mandatory.)

ABOUT THE HOME QUARANTINE SAFETY PROTECTION APP:

*All persons subject to mandatory home quarantine (all Korean nationals and all foreign nationals on long-term visit) are required to install the "HOME QUARANTINE SAFETY PROTECTION" app on their mobile phone and comply with the quarantine rules for 14 days of quarantine. (ID: CORONA)
(If there is any change to your phone number or where you live, you must notify your local public health center as soon as possible.)

HOME QUARANTINE GUIDELINES

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PERSON UNDER MANDATORY HOME QUARANTINE:

- To protect other people in your community from possible infection, do not leave your quarantine location (i.e. your home) as much as possible.
- If you need to leave home for an essential need (such as getting medical care), contact your local public health center first.
- Make sure to secure an independent living space.
- If there is any space in your home that is shared with other household members (such as family members, roommates, and cohabitants), make sure that the common space is frequently ventilated.
- If you are unable to secure an independent living space, ask your local public health center for help.
- Keep your personal items (such as towels, eating utensils, and mobile phones) separate from other household members.
- Immediately report to your local public health center if you begin to show fever, cough, shortness of breath, or other respiratory symptoms.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS LIVING WITH PERSON UNDER MANDATORY HOME QUARANTINE:

- To your best ability, avoid any physical contact with the quarantined household member.
- In situations where you have to come in contact with the quarantined household member, make sure to wear a facemask and keep a distance of at least 2 meters between you and the person.
- Closely monitor the health condition of the quarantined household member.
- Keep clean all frequently touched surfaces and objects including tabletops, door knobs, bathroom fixtures, bedside tables, and keyboards.
- If your work setting involves frequent contact with many people (including but not limited to school, private classes, preschool, kindergarten, social welfare facility, postpartum care center, and healthcare institution), limit or reduce your work capacity as best as possible to minimize contact with others until your household member is released from mandatory home quarantine.

GENERAL INFECTION PREVENTION TIPS

- ✓ Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and running water for over 30 seconds.
- ✓ Cover your nose and mouth using your upper sleeve when coughing.
- ✓ Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.
- ✓ Frequently ventilate your rooms.
- ✓ Wear a facemask if you have fever or respiratory or respiratory symptoms, or when you visit hospitals, clinics, or pharmacies.

*If you leave your quarantine location without permission during your mandatory home quarantine period or otherwise fail to comply with quarantine guidelines, you will be required to wear a Safety Band (a location-tracking wristband that wirelessly connects to your phone's Home Quarantine Safety Protection App).
If you still refuse to comply, you will be ordered to quarantine at a designated facility at your own expense.

※ Failure to comply with this action may result in:

- Criminal penalty of imprisonment up to 1 year or a fine up to 10 million won according to Article 79-3, subparagraphs 3 through 5 of the Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act;
- Civil damages in the event that your failure to comply constitutes violation of law and causes damage to the state due to further transmission of the infectious disease and/or additional measures of disease control/prevention; and/or
- (For foreign nationals) Revocation of visa or residence permit, deportation, and/or prohibition of entry according to the Immigration Act.



SELF-QUARANTINE GUIDELINES

- Appendix 3 to COVID-19 Response Guidelines 9-2 Edition -

- ✓ Do not leave the designated quarantine area.**

 - Visitors are not allowed in self-quarantine area. This includes family members who do not live with you.
※For special circumstances such as caregiver visits, contact your public health center officer first
 - ※ Please comply with quarantine rules to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
Under Article 79-3 (Penalty Provisions) of Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act, quarantine violation is punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine not exceeding KRW 10 million.
- ✓ Make sure your living space is physically separated from others**

 - Ventilate your room frequently by opening the window with the door closed
 - Eat alone
 - Use a separate bathroom and sink if possible
(Shared bathrooms and sinks must be disinfected with a home disinfectant such as chlorine bleach after use)
- ✓ If you need to leave your quarantine area for an essential reason such as getting medical care, contact your public health center officer first.**
- ✓ Avoid all forms of contact (conversation included) with other people in your household.**

 - If such contact is unavoidable, keep a 2-meter distance, wear a mask, and face away from each other.
- ✓ If there are other people living with you, make sure that everyone in your household wears a mask at home at all times.**

(You can take off your mask if you are in complete physical isolation from other household members.)
- ✓ Use your own personal items such as towels, tableware, mobile phones, etc.**

 - Wash your clothes and bedding separately from other people's laundry.
 - Wash your tableware separately from other people's items before letting other people use your items.
- ✓ Follow personal health and hygiene guidelines**

 - Strictly maintain personal hygiene including washing or disinfecting your hands well.
 - If you have coughs, make sure to wear a mask.
 - If you do not have a mask, cover your mouth and nose with your sleeves when coughing.
Wash or disinfect your hands after coughing.
- ✓ Install Self-Quarantine Safety and Protection app on your phone**

 - ※ If you do not own a mobile phone or refuse to install the app, you will be quarantined at a facility.
 - ※ If you violate self-quarantine rules, such as leaving the quarantine area, you will be required to wear a Safety Band. This wristband will wirelessly connect to the Self-Quarantine Safety and Protection app. If you refuse to wear a Safety Band, you will be quarantined at a facility. (You may be charged a fee for facility use)

How to conduct self-monitoring

- ✓ Monitor your health conditions, especially for COVID-19 related symptoms such as respiratory symptoms.
 - ✓ Take your temperature every morning and evening. ✓ Tell your symptoms to a public health center official every day.
- An official from your public health center will be contacting you to check your symptoms during the active monitoring period.
Please self-monitor your symptoms until 14 days have passed after coming into contact with a confirmed case.

Common symptoms of COVID-19

- ✓ fever (37.5 degrees or above)
- ✓ coughs, difficulty in breathing
- ✓ chills, muscle pain, headache
- ✓ sore throat
- ✓ loss of smell or taste
- ✓ pneumonia, etc.

COVID-19 FREE Taxi

How to make reservations and use

Foreign visitors will be provided with a disinfected taxi when visiting the public health centre from self-quarantine facility.

(Available at temporary self quarantine or visitors' temporary living facilities)

Seoul residents entering South Korea may only travel via **personal vehicle or specially designated shuttle taxi/bus.**

1. Personal vehicle (or of guardian's) ※ Masks required, minimal conversations

Get to the designated screening center of your district's public health center.
※ Call and check the hours of operation before visiting.

Receive a diagnostic test at the public health center's screening center.
※ Passport and airline ticket required to receive test

Head home immediately after receiving the diagnostic test.

Self-quarantine for 14 days!
※ Self-quarantine is mandatory even if the test result is negative.

2. Specially designated shuttle taxi (Fare: KRW 65,000 to 160,000; 24-hour operation and fare set by district)

Hail a ride at Seoul Taxi Info Desk.
> Between Gates 12-13 at T1
> Between Gates 2-3 at T2

Get off and receive the test at the screening center.
※ Call the center before visiting. Passport & airline ticket required.

After receiving the diagnostic test, take the specially designated shuttle taxi.
※ Your assigned taxi will wait until testing is complete.

Self-quarantine for 14 days at home!
※ Self-quarantine is mandatory even if the test result is negative.

Emergency Shuttle Bus for International Arrivals (Fare: KRW 16,000)

▶ How to use

- Upon arrival, go to the emergency shuttle bus waiting area. (Incheon Airport - Terminal 1 [1F], Terminal 2 [B1F])
- Check the bus routes and fill out the passenger form. (Routes are classified by zones.) Passengers are only allowed to get off at bus stops designated by the district office.
- Take the shuttle bus to your local district office. (You may make a request to your district office if you do not have a separate mode of personal transportation.)
- Get off at district office and head to your accommodation/residence. (Follow the instructions of the person in charge at the district office.) [Use of personal vehicles are prioritized; ride the district office vehicle if needed]
