**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE DIVISION**

The TEC Division is the nervous system of WFP, connecting staff with each other and with our beneficiaries, donors and partners. As such, we run all vital IT systems which allow WFP to be the lead humanitarian agency of the UN. As the main driver for efficiency gains, TEC leverages expert knowledge of dedicated staff and technological innovations to empower staff globally in effectively implementing the Strategic Plan.

The Global Data Office specializes in offering a wide array of Data and Artificial Intelligence-related services within WFP. This includes workshops and training for data project ideation and solution delivery, comprehensive management of various data tools like Modern Data Platform (MDP), Tableau, DOTS, and SCOPE BI, and specialized services for data source integration, data and AI governance, data analytics and cognitive (AI) and incident management. Additionally, it provides onboarding and consultation for data engineers, supports architectural and technical reviews, and promotes data literacy across the organization through assessments, training, and advocacy.

1. Work with the Field and HQ data teams to process, integrate, model, design and present data in ways to help relevant stakeholders make better decisions.
2. Define requirements and objectives for locally developed data products, liaising closely with relevant stakeholders, including business functions, development and architecture teams.
3. Working with the data architecture team and relevant business units to define and document business rules and logic that drive the design and development of data solutions.
4. Provide quality assurance of imported data, working with relevant stakeholders.
5. Provide applied technical expertise on data storage structures, integration, data cleansing and data visualization best practices.
6. Manage and design the analytical environment, including data sources, analytical models, security, and metadata

**STANDARD MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- Be an undergraduate or master's student or a graduate in Data Management, Statistics, Information Management, Computer Science or other relevant discipline

- Excellent written and spoken English is required (proficiency/level C). Working knowledge of another official UN language (French, Spanish, Arabic, Chinese, Russian plus Portuguese) is an asset.
- Hands-on experience with AWS analytical products or Tableau or PowerBI
- Knowledge and skills using Machine Learning and AI algorithms

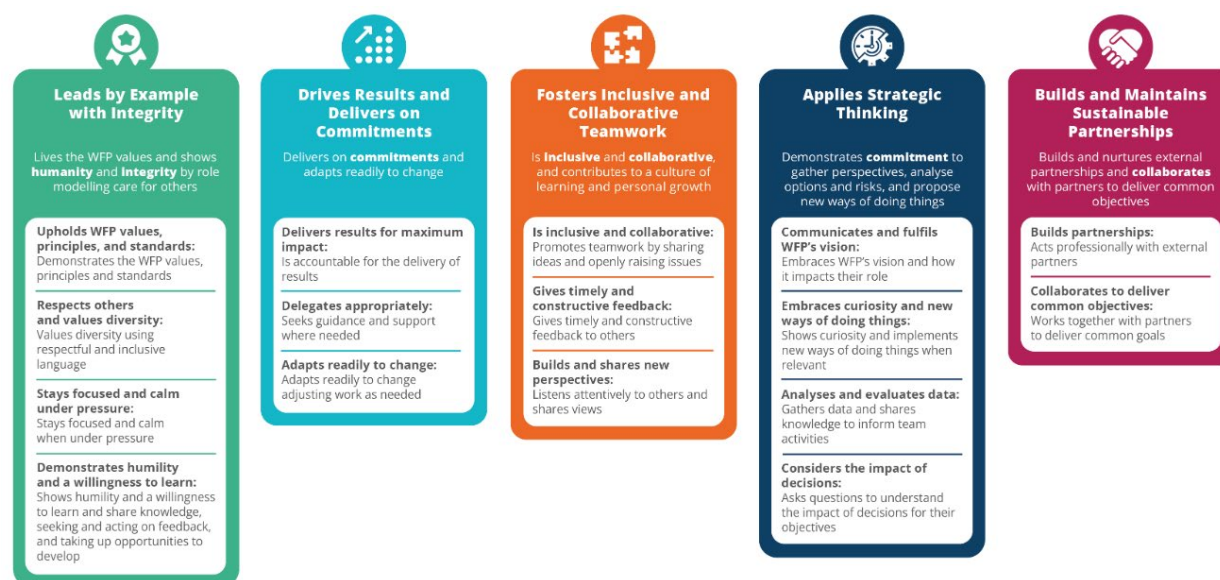
