<Eligibility for the GSFS>

To be considered for the Graduate Scholarship for Foreign Students (GSFS), applicants must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- (a) Nationality: The applicant and both of their parents must not hold Korean nationality.
- (b) Educational Background:
Applicants must have completed their entire formal education from primary school to the final degree required for the applied program outside of Korea.
 - Applicants for Master's or Combined Master's & Doctoral Programs must have completed all education up to the Bachelor's degree outside of Korea.
 - Applicants for Doctoral Programs must have completed all education up to the Master's degree outside of Korea.
(Short-term academic exchange programs such as exchange student programs undertaken in Korea are permitted. However, applicants who have obtained a degree from a Korean university, including through a dual-degree program, are NOT eligible.)
- (c) Academic Qualifications: The applicant must hold an appropriate academic degree (or its recognized equivalent) from an accredited institution outside Korea, as follows:
 - For Master's or Combined Master's & Doctoral Programs: A bachelor's degree or higher
 - For Doctoral Programs: A master's degree or higher
- (d) Program Selection: The applicant must apply to one of the designated colleges or schools participating in the GSFS Program for the Fall 2026 intake. (Please refer to the list of participating colleges/schools provided elsewhere in this catalogue.)
- (e) Admission to SNU: The applicant must not only apply but also be successfully admitted to Seoul National University for the Fall 2026 semester.

<Selection Criteria>

The evaluation and selection of GSFS recipients are conducted independently by each graduate school at Seoul National University. This decentralized approach allows for a comprehensive assessment tailored to the specific standards and requirements of each academic discipline.

When reviewing applications, the selection committees consider a holistic range of factors to identify outstanding candidates. These factors include:

- The applicant's overall academic trajectory and potential

- Performance in previous studies, as evidenced by transcripts and grades
- The quality and feasibility of the proposed study plan
- The depth and sincerity of the personal statement
- Any additional achievements or qualifications relevant to the chosen field of study

· Applicants who hold nationality of countries that are not classified as “Advanced Economies” by the International Monetary Fund (IMF) will be given priority consideration.

2. Scholarship Benefits

<Tuition fee Support>

Recipients of this scholarship will receive full waiver of their tuition fee (except the application fee of KRW 90,000, which must be paid during online admission application) up to 2 academic years (4 semesters).

The recipient must maintain an average grade point of 3.0/4.3 and above in order to sustain the scholarship (Assessment will be done at the end of each semester)

<Living Support>

Monthly Stipends:

-at least KRW 500,000/1 year (Master program applicants)

-at least KRW 500,000/2 years (Doctorate program applicants)

※ Please note that the monthly amount and the duration of the stipend may vary depending on the individual college/school.

Contact details about the scholarship staff at each college/school will be available after you get an acceptance letter from SNU.

<Other Assistance provided>

The Office of Global Affairs (OGA) will provide GSFS students with the following additional assistance:
