

# How to Apply for S-CARD


A. Mobile S-CARD is applicable from March 1<sup>st</sup> for Spring semester / September 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall semester. In order to maintain your mobile card, a card-type S-CARD must be issued within 1 month . For your information, ID-only S-CARD can be issued from March 3<sup>rd</sup>.

B. Functions of S-CARD: Allows you to access the library & any other buildings and to get a discount at on/off campus member stores (ex. cafeteria).

## C. Types of S-CARD

Type	Application Procedure	Note
<b>S-CARD (ID only)</b>	Visit Student Service Center (Bldg.#102, 2 <sup>nd</sup> floor now, Bldg.#67, 2 <sup>nd</sup> floor from March 17th) with an official ID (i.e. Passport, Alien Registration Card).	Bring a ID photo(Size 3*4cm) or send it to the Student Service Center by e-mail ( <a href="mailto:student@snu.ac.kr">student@snu.ac.kr</a> ) with Name / Department / Student Number / Contact number.
<b>S-CARD (ID + Debit Card)</b>	Visit Woori bank on campus with passport or alien registration card and then visit the Student Help Center for ID insertion.  <b>* Please note that this type is only applicable to regular SNU students, not International Exchange/Visiting students.</b>	
<b>Mobile S-CARD</b>	Download 'Seoul National University' Application (Google Play or App Store). → Log in with your mySNU Portal ID & Password → Click the S-CARD icon.  <b>*NFC function:</b> Only android phone users can utilize the NFC function along with the issuance of the mobile S-CARD  <b>*BLE function:</b> Only iphone users can utilize the BLE function along with the issuance of the mobile S-CARD	You must apply for a card-type S-CARD first within a month after the semester begins; otherwise, your mobile S-CARD will not work.
